## **EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 25-97**

(Amending Executive Order 24-178)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 24-178 to handle charges pending against Rejean Junior Louis for possession of methamphetamine, possession of controlled substance, and several violations of probation; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Rejean Junior Louis has been arrested for fleeing or attempting to elude law enforcement, driving while license suspended, resisting an officer-obstruct without violence, IMP sunscreen at top of windshield, and several violations of probation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 24-178 is hereby amended to include the arrest for fleeing or attempting to elude law enforcement, driving while license suspended, resisting an officer-obstruct without violence, IMP sunscreen at top of windshield, and several violations of probation.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 24-178 is ratified and reaffirmed.
