MINUTES – DRAFT #1

1. Jim Kallinger called the meeting to order at 9:10 am and called the roll. Introductions were made.
2. The council members reviewed the minutes of the 14 March 2008 meeting of the council. The members unanimously approved the motion made by Mike Haney and seconded by Bunny Finney to accept the minutes as written. 3. Presentation & Q/A – Roles Community Based Care Agencies could Play with Primary and Secondary Prevention Efforts in Light of syndemics as a Model Approach in Florida. Dr. Patricia Nellius-Guthrie, Executive Director, Community Based Care of Brevard, Inc., provided an overview of the work of the CBC lead agency and a sister agency, Brevard Cares. Brevard Cares provides for wrap around services and supports for families at risk of entering the child welfare system.
