It appears that we are on target for meeting the goal of reducing the elder (ages 65+) suicide rate by one-third by 2010 (17.1% reduction between 2001-2005, 16.2% reduction needed to go between 2005-2010). This appears to be a real decline, as there were 65 fewer suicides in this age group in 2005 than there were in 2001, yet the population in this age group increased by 6.7% during this time.
