Quorum

Noticed meetings of the Commission on Open Government Reform may take place without a quorum of members present. However, formal action must be conducted with a quorum of members present.

Votes

Any recommendation by the Commission that would restrict the public's right of access guaranteed under Article 1, Sec. 24, Fla. Con., including new or expanded exemptions to ch. 119, F.S., or s. 286.011, F.S., require a 2/3 majority vote of Commission members.

Recommendations by the Commission to the Governor, President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives require a majority vote of Commission members.

Voting will be held by roll call with each member's vote being recorded. *Those Commission members unable to attend a meeting who desire to record a vote on action items may submit their vote in writing and such vote will be read into the record of the meeting.*

2008 Legislative Session

Commission members will not endorse specific legislation during the 2008 Legislative Session unless the legislation has been considered and approved by a majority of Commission members present and voting in accordance with the Commission's voting procedures.
