EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 09-223

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 09-45,
AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER 09-102)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 09-45 and amended by Executive Order 09-102, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle the case involving Ryan L. Gainer who was charged with burglary (dwelling/battery); robbery (strong arm); felony battery; trespassing of a structure of conveyance and stalking, false imprisonment; battery; violation of injunction for protection against dating violence and violation of order of pretrial release; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ has advised Governor Charlie Crist that there is an additional charge of resisting an officer without violence, a violation of the criminal laws of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHARLIE CRIST, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 09-45, amended by Executive Order 09-102, is hereby amended to include the additional charge of resisting an officer without violence.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, and including the previous Executive Order 09-102, Executive Order 09-45 is ratified and reaffirmed.
