EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 10-18

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 04-19, as extended by Executive Orders 05-32, 06-14, 07-23, 08-08 and 09-29, to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning the filing of a Petition for Involuntary Commitment under the Jimmy Ryce Act against Khalie Hamid; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has advised the Governor that the duties required by the previous executive assignment have not yet been completed in this case as the trial date is set for February 22, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has further advised the Governor that an extension of this assignment is necessary in order to complete the assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the assignment of the Assigned State Attorney be continued with respect to the above matters, pursuant to Section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHARLIE CRIST, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order:

Section 1.

Executive Order 04-19, as extended by Executive Orders 05-32, 06-14, 07-23, 08-08 and 09-29, is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including February 9, 2011.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before January 9, 2011, if additional time is required.
