Pursuant to Article I, section 24 of the Florida Constitution, and chapter 119, F.S., I hereby request for inspection and/or copying the documents and materials specified herein. The term "documents" shall mean all writings of any kind including the originals and non-identical copies, whether different from the original by reason of a notation made on them, copies or otherwise, including but not limited to; correspondence, memoranda, notes, diaries, statistics, letters, telegrams, minutes, contracts, reports, studies, summaries, worksheets, affidavits, statements, opinions, analyses, pamphlets, books, prospectuses, interoffice and intraoffice memorandums, bulletins, printed matter, test results, computer printouts, teletypes, telexes, data processing input or output, including but not limited to; all electronic communications and all other records kept by electronic means, photographs, charts, microfilm, videotape, recordings, motion pictures, including but not limited to; tapes, cassettes, disks, records, CD's, DVD's and all other things similar to the foregoing including all drafts, alterations, modifications, changes and amendments to the foregoing that pertain to the following:

**Death of Teresa Seivers on or about June 29, 2015 in Bonita Springs, Florida and suspects Curtis Wayne Wright (DOB: 7/21/68 - Soc.Sec.No: 492-84-0093) and Jimmy Rodgers (DOB: 4/11/90 - Soc.Sec.No.: 487-04-5972)**

NOTE: If there are any fees which will be charged for the research and/or copying of this public records request, please inform me before filling my request.

In accordance with Article 1, section 24 of the Florida Constitution,  
and chapter 119, F.S., the following applies:

(4)The custodian of public records shall furnish a copy or a certified copy of the record upon payment of the fee prescribed by law. If a fee is not prescribed by law, the following fees are authorized:

(a)1. Up to 15 cents per one-sided copy for duplicated copies of not more than 14 inches by 8 1/2 inches;

2. No more than an additional 5 cents for each two-sided copy; and

3. For all other copies, the actual cost of duplication of the public record.

Relative to the copying of the above, my preferred method for documents is a “two-sided copy”. Please provide receipts for your cost of duplication of all media. Should you deny my request, or any part of the request, please state in writing the basis for the denial, including the exact statutory citation authorizing the denial as required by s. 119.07(1)(d), F.S.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

In accordance with Article 1, section 24 of the Florida Constitution, and chapter 119, F.S., the following applies:

119.10 Violation of chapter; penalties.—

(1)Any public officer who:

(a)Violates any provision of this chapter commits a noncriminal infraction, punishable by fine not exceeding \$500.

(b)Knowingly violates the provisions of s. 119.07(1) is subject to suspension and removal or impeachment and, in addition, commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

(2)Any person who willfully and knowingly violates:

(a)Any of the provisions of this chapter commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

(b)Section 119.105 commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
