RE: Application and accompanying documents filed by Walter P. Drabinski for the recently vacated Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority (“FKAA”) board seat

Dear Sir/Madam:

This law firm represents an interested party in connection with Monroe County, Florida Circuit Court case of *First State Bank of the Florida Keys v. Vantage Property Development, LLC; Walter P. Drabinski; JoAnne C. Drabinski, et al.*, Case No.: 13-CA-596-K (the “Case”).

Pursuant to Chapter 119, *Florida Statutes*, this is a request to examine and copy public records as described below which relate to Walter P. Drabinski. We are addressing the request to your office at the request of Robert T. Feldman, Esq., General Counsel for the FKAA, to whom the original request was directed.

For the purposes of this request:

(A) The term “document” shall mean the original, or, if unavailable, a copy of the original, in draft or final form, of all writings, tangible things, typings, letters, correspondence, electronic mail or other communications, memoranda (internal or otherwise), confirmations, drafts, notes, work papers, bills, ledgers, status reports, diaries, daily reports, minutes of meetings, records, journals, entries in journals, financial statements, audit reports, financial data, status reports, calendars, schedules, studies, summaries, reports, charts, books, drawings, diagrams, exhibits, video tapes, photographs, movies, tapes, recordings, transcripts, statements, contracts, purchase orders, subcontracts, amendments, proposals, estimates, data sheets, computer printouts, computer diskettes or drives, compact disks (CDS), optical disks, whether sent or received, and all copies or reproductions thereof which are different in any way from the original, regardless of whether designated confidential, privileged, or otherwise.

(B) The term “relating to” means embodying, concerning, respecting, referring to, summarizing, digesting, tending to establish, delegating from, commenting on, responding to, disagreeing with, showing, describing, analyzing, representing, constituting or including.

(C) “FKAA” shall include all FKAA offices operating from any location, its board, representatives, agents, attorneys, employees, and all other persons acting on its behalf.

(D) “Including” means including, but not limited to.

(E) “And” as well as “or” shall be construed disjunctively as well as conjunctively as necessary to bring within the scope of the request documents which might otherwise be construed to be outside its scope.

Documents Requested

Please produce all of the following documents within Gov. Rick Scott’s Appointment Office and/or FKAA’s possession or control as those terms are defined pursuant to F.S. §119:

1. The written application submitted by Walter P. Drabinski for the seat on the board of FKAA.
2. All personal and business financial information including financial statements and tax returns submitted by Walter P. Drabinski in support of his application for the seat on the board of FKAA.
3. All other documents submitted by Walter P. Drabinski in support of his application.

If you contend that any requested document or any part of a requested document is subject to an exemption from the disclosure requirements of chapter 119, please identify the document or portion thereof withheld, identify the statute that you contend provides the exemption upon which you rely to withhold the document, and state in writing and with particularity the basis of your conclusion that the record is exempt. *See* 119.07(1). Pursuant to section 119.07(1)(d), if a portion of a document contains exempt information, you must nonetheless produce the document with any exempted information excised.

I would like to review and/or be provided copies of these documents as soon as possible. My client acknowledges responsibility for the statutory copying fees. Accordingly, please contact me at your earliest convenience to arrange a specific time and place for the document inspection.
