STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 18-345 (DISSOLUTION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 18-329)

WHEREAS, Executive Order 18-329 was issued accepting the findings, recommendations of the Commission on Ethics Final Order and Public Report No. 18-052, finding that Robert K. Robinson, the former acting city attorney and city attorney for the City of North Port, violated section 112.313(6), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida to dissolve Executive Order 18-329 and issue Executive Order 18-346 with corrected information;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately: <u>Section 1.</u>

Executive Order 18-329 is hereby dissolved.
