On Monday, May 20, 2019, former Representative Sandy D'Alemberte, of Tallahassee, passed away. D'Alemberte served in the Florida House of Representatives, representing Dade County, from 1966-1972. He later served as the dean of Florida State University College of Law from 1984-1989, and then as president of the university from 1994-2003.

As a symbol of respect for the memory of Representative D'Alemberte, and his service to Florida, I hereby direct the flags of the United States and the State of Florida to be flown at half-staff at the Leon County Courthouse in Tallahassee, Florida, the City Hall of Tallahassee, Florida and at the State Capitol in Tallahassee, Florida, from sunrise to sunset on Wednesday, June 5, 2019.
