RE: Flags at Half-Staff in Honor of Former Florida House Speaker Donald L. Tucker

On Tuesday, September 24, 2019, former Florida House Speaker Donald Legrand Tucker passed away. Tucker represented Leon, Franklin and Wakulla Counties in the Florida House of Representatives from 1966 through 1978, serving six terms. He served as the Speaker of the Florida House for two consecutive terms. In 1977, Governor Reuben Askew signed legislation naming Tallahassee's civic center "The Donald L. Tucker Civic Center" in recognition of his service and commitment to the Capital.

As a symbol of respect for the memory of former Florida House Speaker Donald L. Tucker, and his service to our state, I hereby direct the flags of the United States and the State of Florida to be flown at half-staff at the County Courthouse of Leon County, Florida, the City Hall of Tallahassee, Florida, and at the State Capitol in Tallahassee, Florida, from sunrise to sunset on Friday, October 4, 2019.
