### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-08

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 21-249)

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable GINGER BOWDEN MADDEN, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 21-249 to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a complaint made against William Floyd Collier Jr. for fleeing and attempting to elude (injury or death), possession of amphetamines/methamphetamine and false imprisonment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable LARRY BASFORD, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that William Floyd Collier Jr. also has two pending violation of probation cases; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS**, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 21-249 is hereby amended to include the two pending violation of probation cases.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 21-249 is ratified and reaffirmed.
