On behalf of Governor DeSantis, I am requesting that you convene the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission for the purpose of selecting and submitting to the Governor the names of highly qualified lawyers for appointment to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit. This appointment is to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Judge Mily Rodriguez Powell, effective February 28, 2022. The Governor strongly prefers submission of the maximum number of nominees (six) for the vacancy.

The Commission's deadline for completion of this undertaking is **Saturday**, **February 19**, **2022**. In cases where a discretionary extension of no more than thirty days is needed, as authorized by Article V, Section 11(c) of the Florida Constitution, please contact me.
