OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-35

(Amending Executive Order 22-23)

WHEREAS, on January 28, 2022, Executive Order 22-23 was issued assigning the Third Judicial Circuit to the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle allegations made against Philip Scott Adler in Columbia County Agency Case Number CCSO21OFF005268; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 22-23 was intended to reflect that JOHN F. DURRETT, State Attorney for the Third Judicial Circuit of Florida, had requested an executive assignment regarding Philip Scott Adler in Columbia County Agency Case Number CCSO21OFF005268, and BRIAN S. KRAMER, State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable JOHN F. DURRETT in this case; and

WHEREAS, this Executive Order amends Executive Order 22-23 as provided herein.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-23 is hereby amended to reflect that wherever the words “JOHN F. DURRETT” or “Third Judicial Circuit” appear, they are to be replaced with the words “BRIAN S. KRAMER” or “Eighth Judicial Circuit,” and vice versa.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-23 is ratified and reaffirmed.
