OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-132

(Amending Executive Order 22-104)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 22-96 to the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Phillip Nathaniel West for criminal mischief \$1,000 or more and resisting/obstructing an officer without violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DENNIS W. WARD, State Attorney for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Phillip Nathaniel West has also been arrested for grand theft motor vehicle, resisting/obstructing an officer without violence and operating a motor vehicle without a license.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-96 is hereby amended to include the arrest for grand theft motor vehicle, resisting/obstructing an officer without violence and operating a motor vehicle without a license.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-96 is ratified and reaffirmed.
