EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-139

(Amending Executive Order 22-132)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 22-96 to the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Phillip Nathaniel West for criminal mischief \$1,000 or more and resisting/obstructing an officer without violence; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 22-132 was issued amending Executive Order 22-96, assigning the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against and an additional arrest of Phillip Nathaniel West for grand theft motor vehicle, resisting/obstructing an officer without violence and operating a motor vehicle without a license; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 22-132 was intended to reflect the amendment of Executive Order 22-96.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-132 is amended to replace the reference to Executive Order 22-104 with Executive Order 22-96.


Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-132, amending Executive Order 22-96, is ratified and reaffirmed.
