### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-140

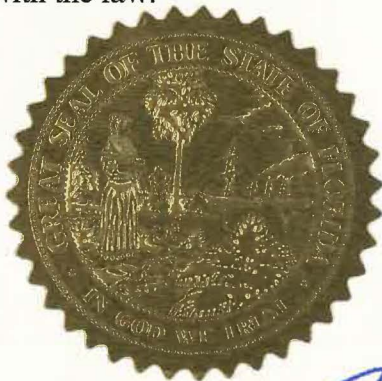
(Declaring a Vacancy on the Lee County Board of County Commissioners)

**WHEREAS**, Frank Mann, a member of the Board of County Commissioners, Lee County, has passed away; and


**WHEREAS**, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent public officer; and

**WHEREAS**, section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to the vacancy in office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS**, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Frank Mann, a vacancy exists on the Board of County Commissioners, Lee County, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
