OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-174 (Amending Executive Order 22-153)

WHEREAS, the Honorable JOHN F. DURRETT, State Attorney for the Third Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 22-153 to the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a complaint filed against Clovis Watson IV for felony driving while license suspended; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRIAN S. KRAMER, State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that, due to a new law violation, Clovis Watson IV has a pending violation of probation in case #01-2021-CT-002225-A.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-153 is hereby amended to include the pending violation of probation in case #01-2021-CT-002225-A.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-153 is ratified and reaffirmed.
