EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-175

(Amending Executive Order 22-104, as amended by Executive Order 22-120)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 22-104, as amended by Executive Order 22-120, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Emmanuel David Bradley for misdemeanor battery and criminal mischief/\$200-\$1,000; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Emmanuel David Bradley has also been arrested for aggravated battery of an elderly person and battery on a medical care provider.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-104 is hereby amended to include the arrest for aggravated battery of an elderly person and battery on a medical care provider.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-104, as amended by Executive Order 22-120, is ratified and reaffirmed.
