

Governor's Internship Program

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What semesters do you offer internships?

Internships are available each fall, spring and summer semester and are modeled after the academic calendar year.

2. Do you offer remote internship opportunities?

No, this internship takes place on-site at the Florida State Capitol building in Tallahassee.

3. Is my preferred office placement guaranteed?

No, office needs for an intern change on a semester-by-semester basis.

4. Is this internship paid?

No, this is an unpaid internship.

5. Who is eligible to apply?

Students who are currently enrolled in a college, university, vocational/technical school, or community college are welcome to apply.

6. What is the minimum GPA requirement?

Applicants should maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average.

7. How many hours a week are interns expected to work?

Interns are expected to work 15-20 hours per week during the Monday-Friday 8:00am-5:00pm work week.

8. Is this internship open to non-Florida resident applicants?

Non-Florida resident students are welcome to apply.

9. Are there opportunities for employment after the internship?

Employment post-internship is not guaranteed.

10. Is academic credit available through this internship?

Yes. Accepted interns must coordinate with their home institution to ensure all forms are submitted and approved in order to receive academic credit for this internship.
