OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-220 (State Attorney Executive Assignment)

WHEREAS, the Honorable SUSAN S. LOPEZ, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Loronne Wells was arrested for resisting an officer without violence, possession of cannabis with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver, possession of controlled substance (oxycodone), and fleeing to elude highspeed. As a result of this arrest, he also has a pending violation of probation. Co-defendant Davone Elisha Wells was arrested for resisting officer without violence and possession of cannabis with intent to sell, manufacture or delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable SUSAN S. LOPEZ has also advised the Governor that she is a witness to this incident; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable SUSAN S. LOPEZ, to avoid a conflict of interest or any appearance of impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified herself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney regarding the investigation and prosecution of this case and all related matters regarding Loronne Wells and Davone Elisha Wells; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT discharge the duties of the Honorable SUSAN S. LOPEZ, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1. The Honorable BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the “Assigned State Attorney,” is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable SUSAN S. LOPEZ, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, regarding the investigation and prosecution of this case and all related matters regarding Loronne Wells and Davone Elisha Wells.

Section 2. The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed herein.

Section 3. All residents of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4. The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including October 3, 2023.

Section 5. The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before September 3, 2023, if additional time is required.
