OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-262 (Amending Executive Order 22-231)

WHEREAS, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 22-231 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Gabriel Santos for two counts of unarmed burglary of an unoccupied conveyance; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Gabriel Santos has a new charge of burglary of an unarmed unoccupied conveyance, case #22009621CF10A.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-231 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of unarmed burglary of an unoccupied conveyance, case #22009621CF10A.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-231 is ratified and reaffirmed.
