## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-267 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 22-252)

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2022, Executive Order 20-252 was issued extending Executive Order 21-226 assigning the Honorable Ginger Bowden Madden, State Attorney for First Judicial Circuit of Florida to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida concerning charges pending against Dorothy Annette Conkle; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 22-252 stated the executive assignment was extended by one year including October 28, 2022, and should have reflected the correct date of October 28, 2023; and


