EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 22-277

(Amending Executive Order 22-259)

WHEREAS, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida was assigned by Executive Order 22-259 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges against Christopher Marquis Tuller for touch or strike/battery and unarmed burglary of an occupied dwelling; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable AMIRA D. FOX, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Christopher Marquis Tuller has an additional arrest resisting an officer without obstruction.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-259 is hereby amended to include the additional arrest for resisting an officer without obstruction.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-259 is ratified and reaffirmed.
