EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-04

(Declaring a Vacancy on the Gulf County Board of County Commissioners)

WHEREAS, Billy Traylor, a member of the Board of County Commissioners, Gulf County, passed away on November 25, 2022; and

WHEREAS, article X, section 3 of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office occurs upon the death of an incumbent public officer; and

WHEREAS, section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor must file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to the vacancy in office.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Billy Traylor, a vacancy exists on the Board of County Commissioners, Gulf County, which I will fill in compliance with the law.
