### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-07

(Declaring a Vacancy in the Miami-Dade Clerk of Courts)

**WHEREAS**, Harvey Ruvin, the Miami-Dade Clerk of Courts, passed away on December 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, article X, section 3 of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office occurs upon the death of an incumbent public officer; and

**WHEREAS**, section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor must file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to the vacancy in office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS**, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Harvey Ruvin, a vacancy exists in the Miami-Dade Clerk of Courts Office, which I will fill in compliance with the law.
