OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-34 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 23-31)

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2023, Executive Order 23-31 was issued assigning the Honorable William M. Gladson, State Attorney for Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida to the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Tureygua Tinaru for two counts of written threats to kill or do bodily harm and one count of aggravated stalking with credible threat; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 23-31 reflected the defendant's name as Tureygua Tinaru while her correct name is Tureygua Inaru; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 23-31 is amended to reflect the defendant's name as Tureygua Inaru.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 23-31 is ratified and reaffirmed.
