To further Florida's mission of expanding and improving cancer outcomes in Florida through the <u>Florida Cancer Connect Collaborative</u>, First Lady Casey DeSantis charged the Agency for Health Care Administration and Florida Department of Health to enhance the foundation of cancer data in Florida.

There is currently no population-level cancer recurrence data system in the United States. Florida will be the first state in the country to collect cancer recurrence data. This achievement requires partnership across state government, academia, health care facilities, practitioners, and insurers.

As such, the State of Florida is reaching out to statutorily required reporting facilities to request additional patient outcome data from hospitals statewide, specifically:

- Remission/Disease Progression
- Recurrence

Historically, cancer mortality and overall survival rates have been sufficient to assess the progression of cancer and care. Fortunately, cancer care has improved and reduced mortality – but the structure of data has not followed this progress.

<u>Cancer recurrence and survivorship</u> are key outcomes for measuring the burden of illness, assessing the quality of cancer care, and informing treatment decisions.

According to the Journal of the National Cancer Institute, cancer deaths are occurring in patients who previously completed definitive treatment and were determined to be disease-free but experienced a cancer recurrence.

This is the Cancer Connect Collaborative's first action to meet their objective to identify the reason data is hard to access and dismantle those barriers. We appreciate your partnership in this endeavor and look forward to leading the nation in the fight against cancer.
