OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-58 (Amending Executive Order 22-148)

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 22-148 to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle an allegation made against Tai T. Nguyen for aggravated battery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable AMIRA D. FOX, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Tai T. Nguyen has been issued a citation for failure to register a vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to “take care that the laws be faithfully executed,” and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 22-148 is hereby amended to include the citation for failure to register a vehicle.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 22-148 is ratified and reaffirmed.
