EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-77

(Amending Executive Order 23-31, amended by Executive Order 23-34)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MONIQUE H. WORRELL, State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 23-31, as amended by Executive Order 23-34, to the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Tureygua Inaru for two counts of written threats to kill or do bodily harm and one count of aggravated stalking with credible threat; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MONIQUE H. WORRELL, State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Tureygua Inaru has an additional Case Number 2023-MM-681 for stalking and Case Number 2023-CG-926 for three counts for solicitation to commit first degree murder.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 23-31, as amended by Executive Order 23-34, is hereby amended to include Case Number 2023-MM-681 and Case Number 2023-CF-926.

<u>Section 2.</u> Except as amended herein, Executive Order 23-31, as amended by Executive Order 23-34, is ratified and reaffirmed.
