On behalf of Governor DeSantis, I am requesting that you convene the Twentieth Judicial Circuit Judicial Nominating Commission for the purpose of selecting and submitting to the Governor the names of highly qualified lawyers for appointment to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit. These appointments are to fill the vacancies created by the retirement of Judge Hugh Hayes, effective November 18, 2022, and the resignation of Judge Scott Cupp, effective March 1, 2023. The Governor strongly prefers submission of the maximum number of nominees (six) for each vacancy.

The Commission's deadline for completion of this undertaking is **Tuesday**, **February 21**, **2023**. In cases where a discretionary extension of no more than fifteen days is needed, as authorized by Article V, Section 11(c) of the Florida Constitution, please contact me.

Administrative support for the Commission will be provided by the Governor's Office, pursuant to section 43.291(7), Florida Statutes. This includes all essential administrative needs such as document distribution, public announcements and the like.
