EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 23-93

(Amending Executive Order 23-52)

WHEREAS, the Honorable HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 23-52, to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Joshua Christopher Arroyo for aggravated assault of a law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of the State of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that Joshua Christopher Arroyo's codefendant Thomas James Hughes was arrested for assault of police officer/firefighter/intake officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 23-52 is hereby amended to include co-defendant Thomas James Hughes who was arrested for assault of policer officer/firefighter/intake officer.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Executive Order 23-52 is ratified and reaffirmed.
