SB102 (2023) included **\$100 million for the Hometown Heroes Program** providing down payment assistance for law enforcement officers, firefighters, educators, EMTs, teachers, nurses and others.

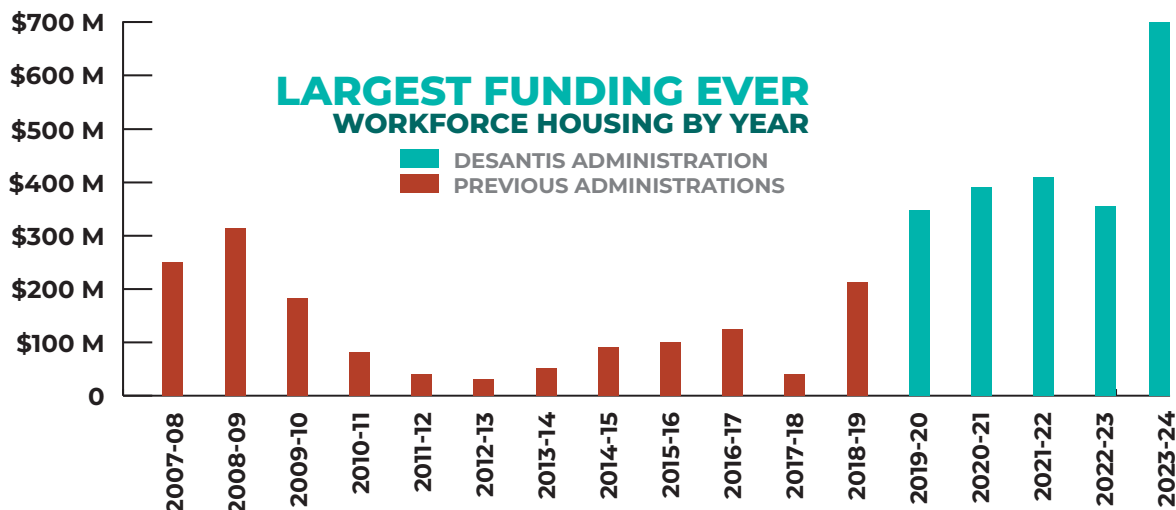
More than **\$89 million** to help these heroes achieve homeownership has already been awarded.
