STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 24-06

(State Attorney Executive Assignment)

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM M. GLADSON, State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RON DESANTIS that James Patrick Maguire has been arrested for driving under the influence, driving while license suspended, and possession of drug paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM M. GLADSON has also advised the Governor that James Patrick Maguire is related to an employee of the state attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM M. GLADSON, to avoid a conflict of interest or any appearance of impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified himself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney regarding the investigation and prosecution of this case and all related matters regarding James Patrick Maguire; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANDREW A. BAIN, State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable ANDREW A. BAIN discharge the duties of the Honorable WILLIAM M. GLADSON, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RON DESANTIS, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

- a E - .

Section 1. The Honorable ANDREW A. BAIN, State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the "Assigned State Attorney," is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable WILLIAM M. GLADSON, State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida, regarding the investigation and prosecution of this case and all related matters regarding James Patrick Maguire.

Section 2. The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed herein.

Section 3. All residents of the Fifth Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4. The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including January 22, 2025.

Section 5. The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before December 22, 2024, if additional time is required.
