Top 3 needs are housing, utility and food assistance. 69% of contacts requested basic need assistance (those top 3 needs). In 2013 79 people in Seminole County called due to suicidal behavior. They do follow up calls for safety assurance (except for domestic violence cases for obvious safety reasons). 85% of those that reach out in crisis de-escalate. 898211 is the # to text 24/7 for assistance as well. FYI-Google text is free. Salvation Army, Catholic Charities and Jewish Family Services in Seminole County contracts with 211 for financial services. 211 is also the National Disaster Distress Helpline for the USA as of 12-31-13.</p>
