

SHIP Health Protection: prevent & reduce unintentional & intentional injuries to children

- **4.1.2** Develop & implement a statewide early childhood (ages 1–4) safety & drowning prevention campaign by 12/31/12
- **4.1.3** Reduce rate of injury deaths among Florida resident children (ages 0–14) from 9.0 / 100,000 to 7.6 / 100,000 by 12/31/15

SHIP Access to Care: meet special health care needs of children

- **AC 6.1.1** Collaborate with DCF in provision of care coordination services for children clinically eligible for out-of-home care by 6/30/13

In transitioning from child-centered to adult-oriented healthcare systems:

- **AC 6.2.1** Provide assistance to primary care providers by 6/30/13
- **AC6.3.1** Provide transition education & activities for by 6/30/13

SHIP Chronic Disease Prevention: ↑ access to resources that promote healthy behaviors

- **CD2.3.2** ↑ by 20% the number of schools implementing Healthy School Program or Healthier US School Challenge by 6/30/14
- **CD2.3.4** ↓ percentage of adolescents who are overweight from 13.6% to 12.9% by 12/31/15
