

Alan Abramowitz is the Executive Director of the Florida Statewide Guardian ad Litem Program. Appointed to this position in 2010, last year he led over 13,000 volunteers, reaching over 39,000 children in 2018. Alan is board certified in Juvenile Law and has argued before the Florida Supreme Court on children's issues. Prior to working with the Guardian ad Litem Program, Alan worked at the Department of Children and Families where he served in a variety of leadership positions, including State director of the Family Safety Program Office, Regional Director, and Chief Legal Counsel for the Central Florida region. He has also worked as Assistant General Counsel for the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice, as an assistant state attorney, and assistant public defender for the State of Florida.

Alan volunteered for the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees in Kenya in 1994 and served in the Peace Corps in Thailand from 1990 to 1992. He also served in the U.S. Army Reserves and the Florida Army National Guard as a Signal and JAG officer. Alan holds a Juris Doctorate from Florida State University and master's degrees in public administration from UCF and in Sociology from Kansas State University.
