The presentation was conducted in partnership with FRIENDS, National Resource Center for Community Based Child Abuse Prevention Program, Child Welfare League of America and Healthy Families Florida. The objective of the training was for participants to integrate the protective factors framework with the principles of trauma-informed care and the avoidance of a cultural bias while working with at-risk families. This presentation has become so popular that it has been requested to repeat in next year's Child Protection Summit.
