- Lauren informed the member that Kathy Rogers was named Child Welfare Integration Coordinator at SFBHN and is currently working with DCF Family Safety to train CPI. Also there is a new IFS protocol in place as of Feb. 1st. 2014
- ConnectFamilies shared that on the prevention side they are seeing a lot of DV cases with mental health issues. They are looking at protective risk factors in Little Havana and Allapatha. They have also been working on TTT with Peer Leaders and invited DCF to present on Safe sleeping
- Claudia will reach out to Christina at the governor's office to find out about the new template for the 2015 Plan and any State wide events for the month of April.
- Lauren from DCF will take the lead to organize an event at DCF. Reach out to Amigos for Kids to find out the events they have planned for April.
