## Review of Workgroup

- Purpose: To identify and outline a comprehensive approach for the criminal background screening for those who serve vulnerable populations
- Membership: DOEA (Chair), AHCA, APD, DCF, DOE (Vocational Rehabilitation), DOH, DJJ, and FDLE.
- □ Workgroup issued a report to the Governor and developed a legislative proposal



#### 2012 Legislative Session

- Worked with the sponsors of SB 320 (Sen. Storms) and HB 943 (Rep. Holder) to develop amendments based on the workgroup's legislative proposal
  - There were 15 amendments on HB 943 (3 committees of reference)
  - There were 3 amendments on SB 320 (2 committees of reference), including 1 strike-all amendment
  - HB 943, as amended, was passed by the House (114-0) and taken up and subsequently passed by the Senate (39-0)

#### Implementation

- ☐ There are four distinct phases of implementation:
  - □ Immediate changes (exemptions to screening, changes to certain definitions and provisions)
  - Florida Department of Education, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation new screening requirements
  - Live scan vendor requirements
  - Development of the Care Provider Background Screening Clearinghouse
