Visions help the clients to create their own realistic service plans. Visions provide transportation for clients, attend staffing, and advocate for the child or whole family. Visions also provide individual psychotherapy, family counseling, group therapy, children's therapy, mental health evaluations, parent counseling, and psychological evaluations.

Minutes: Sandra Grafton (CAPTF Secretary) took minutes.

Voting: Quorum was reached. There was a motion to approve the previous CAPTF minutes. The minutes were approved with the following changes: change Goodwill Self Sufficiency to Goodwill Job Connections and change Kendra's last name to Musselle.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer report was provided by Elaine Cauthen. Elaine reported that Kendra may be filling in for her from time to time to give the Treasurer's Report. The CAPTF bank balance was \$6,807.77 as of 12/31/12. There are 20 current paid members and quorum is 11. Total received from membership payments calculated as of 1/8/2013 was \$1750.00. Bag Logo Sponsors balance is \$1000.00 as of 1/8/13.

Data Report: The data report was presented by Shana Sullivan. Shana reported that there were 424 child protective investigations during the month of December in Seminole County to result in 28 criminal investigations. There were 8 families that had removals to include 8 children total in December 2012. There have been 4325 child protective investigations this year to date in Seminole County to result in 413 criminal investigations. There have been 94 families that had removals to include 140 children total in 2012. Shana reported that the City and County Investigative Bureau has created a special task force to combat the prescription pill addiction epidemic.

Committee Reports:

- Resource Guide:** Lauren's volunteers have been updating the Resource Guide. They are sending the updates to seminolecaptf@gmail.com. The bag purchase logos deadline is 2/15/13.)
- **-Communication Committee:** Chelsey Dygan announced that the anti-co-sleeping campaign poster was designed by Jeff Griesemer and then laminated by Shana Sullivan. Carmen Guzman will drop off the posters at the hospitals and OBGYN offices through Seminole County. The rest of the committee will drop off posters at various pediatricians through Seminole County. Jeff stated he will create a letter to pass put with the flyers. Mary Elizabeth McIlvane asked to make a press release. Jeff stated that he will complete this. He will try to coordinate an event for everyone to wear blue for the media.
- Chelsea will schedule the next Protective Investigators' breakfast.
- **-Programs:** David Parlapiano stated that the Community Walk will be on 4/12/13. Shana Sullivan will help to choose an appropriate location and will arrange for police protection assistance during the walk.

Children's Cabinet Update: no update

- **New or Old Business:** David Parlapiano and Jeff Griesemer announced that they would work on updating the CAPTF By-Laws. They found that the agency membership cost is \$100 and an individual membership fee is \$25. They also found that a proxy should sign the Proxy form. David said that the Health Council has been with CAPTF as the fiscal agency around 2004. The task force started in 1994.

- Shana Sullivan announced that Captain Barnett is stepping down from his position as Captain on 4/1 /13. She also reported that Jenifer Jenkins was a lieutenant and was promoted to Captain of Seminole County.
