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


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POSITIVITY RATE BY AGE GROUP




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FATALITIES BY DAY



This week, AHCA issued emergency rules requiring **mandatory testing every two weeks** of ALL staff in Florida nursing homes and assisted living facilities.


COVID-19 DEDICATED NURSING FACILITIES IN FLORIDA

Statewide in Florida




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PERCENT OF LTC FACILITIES: NEVER HAD A COVID-19 CASE



Hospitalization data as reported by facilities to AHCA Emergency Status System (ESS).


THEN AND NOW

PHASE 1: Required long-term care facilities to transfer COVID-19 positive residents out of the facility if it was unable to provide adequate care and isolation.

These positive residents may not return to their facility until they are COVID-19 free. **Still in effect.**

NOW: On any given day, Florida hospitals collectively are boarding anywhere from approximately 250 to 450 medically stable COVID-19 positive long-term care residents.
