WHAT IS A CASE?

A new case means an individual has tested positive for COVID-19 for the first time.

An individual who tests positive may be:

- Asymptomatic
- Symptomatic but not clinical
- Symptomatic and clinical



COVID-19 TESTING EVOLUTION IN FLORIDA:

February and early March: test if symptomatic and traveled to China (or other international location)

Mid-March through April: test if 65+ and symptomatic regardless of travel history (age limit gradually lowered as April wore on)

May (re-opening): test regardless of age and symptoms



MEDIAN AGE OF NEW CASES FOR 6/19 IN SELECT FLORIDA COUNTIES:

- Broward: 32
- Duval: 29
- Hillsborough: 30
 - Orange: 29
- Pinellas: 29
- Seminole: 27



FLORIDA'S HOSPITAL SYSTEM

- Twice as many beds available than before the pandemic as a percentage.
- Far fewer COVID-19 patients in ICU and on ventilators than in April.
- Non-COVID hospital patients are tested for COVID.
