STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-245 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 11-231)

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 11-231 to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to handle the charge of leaving the scene of a crash with property damage and all other matters related to Jimmy E. Stanford; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that an additional charge of driving under the influence has been filed against Jimmy E. Stanford; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-231 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of driving under the influence.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-231 is ratified and reaffirmed.
