EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-40

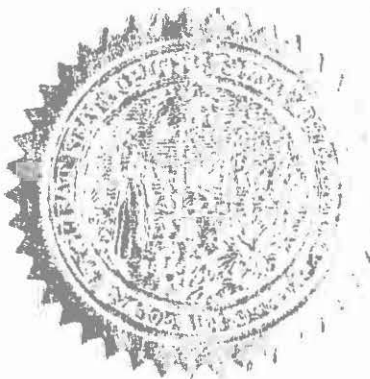
WHEREAS, the Honorable Jefferson W. Morrow, Circuit Court Judge, Fourth Judicial Circuit, died on March 2, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent officer; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Jefferson W. Morrow, a vacancy exists in the Fourth Judicial Circuit, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
