## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-48

WHEREAS, Executive Order 11-42 declared a vacancy in the Ninth Judicial Circuit due to the death of Judge Richard Conrad; and

WHEREAS, it is determined that Judge Richard Conrad officially retired in 2006 and thereafter served the Court as a Senior Judge, and, therefore, there is no vacancy in the Ninth Judicial Circuit; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida that Executive Order 11-42 be dissolved;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Executive Order 11-42 is hereby dissolved.
