## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 11-53

WHEREAS, by Executive Order 11-46 the Honorable Glenn Hess, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit was assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable William Eddins as they relate to the motion for termination of probation requested by Charles Cavet White; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable William Eddins has advised that the defendant's motion for termination of probation was denied and a court order was entered on March 2, 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida that Executive Order 11-46 be dissolved;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-46 is hereby dissolved.
