## STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-124 (Amending Executive Order 12-108)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-108, to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle the charge of domestic battery pending against Brandon Westcott; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable PETER ANTONACCI, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there is now an additional charge of violation of probation pending against Brandon Westcott; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately: Section 1.

Executive Order 11-108 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of violation of probation.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-108 is ratified and reaffirmed.
