OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-125 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-110)

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-110, to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges of burglary of a dwelling, grand theft, and dealing in stolen property and has also been charged with driving on a suspended license pending against Megan Demonbreun; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are now an additional charges of grand theft, grand theft auto, giving false verification to a pawn shop and dealing in stolen property pending against Megan Demonbreun; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional charges in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-110 is hereby amended to include the additional charges of grand theft, grand theft auto, giving false verification to a pawn shop and dealing in stolen property.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-110 is ratified and reaffirmed.
