OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-127 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-47)

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANGELA COREY, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-47 to the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle allegations made against James Thomas Sims, David Page Hayes and Gerard Francis Haley, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are now two additional citations pending against Gerard Francis Haley, Jr. for the smell of soft-shell turtle that was taken from the wild and possession of soft-shell turtle out of season; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANGELA COREY, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional citations in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 11-47 is hereby amended to include the additional citations filed against Gerard Francis Haley, Jr. for sell of soft-shell turtle that was taken from the wild and possession of soft-shell turtle out of season.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-47 is ratified and reaffirmed.
